Utah Olympic Oval and KOPFC Team Up For the 2nd Summer of the Food Truck League

Kearns, UT (May 23, 2017) – The Utah Olympic Oval is proud to announce its partnership with the Utah Food Truck League for its second summer in a row. NEW this year the Utah Olympic Oval will also be partnering up with the Kearns Oquirrh Park Fitness Center to build upon last summer’s successful Wednesday night food events. Starting Wednesday, June 7th, and every Wednesday night during the summer, patrons can visit the KOPFC South Entrance parking lot in front of the Utah Olympic Oval for some great food from around the Salt Lake Valley before enjoying [public skating](#) and [swimming](#).

With the popularity of the food truck league last summer and the growing popularity of food truck cuisine around Utah, the Utah Olympic Oval wants to create a great family experience with some spectacular food and “Beat the Heat” activities, Families are offered with some fun ice skating in the LEED-certified, climate-controlled arena with temperatures between 63 to 65 degrees Fahrenheit of the Olympic Oval or the opportunity to take a swim in one of the KOPFC multiple outdoor and indoor swimming facilities. The food trucks will be in a new location for 2017, right off of 4800 west in the KOPFC South Entrance parking lot of the KOPFC from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm with Public Skating open from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm and Public Swimming open until 8:00 pm. Public Skating admission is \$3.50 for Ages 3 to 12; \$5 for Adults 13 and up. Public Swimming admission is \$5.75 for Adults, \$5 for Ages 3 to 17 and \$4 for Seniors 55+.

“With last summer’s very successful Wednesday night food truck events we wondered how we could make it even more enjoyable for West Bench residents,” said Jason Dyer, Olympic Oval Marketing Manager. “This year families can heat up with some great cuisine then cool off with ice skating in the Utah Olympic Oval arena or swimming at the KOPFC!”
