Job Title: Ski Lift Mechanic

The Lift Mechanic is responsible for performing all routine maintenance procedures under the guidance of the Lift Operations Supervisor.

Major Tasks, Responsibilities and Accountability

- Ensures the safe and reliable mechanical operation of assigned lifts
- Performs maintenance procedures and troubleshooting with minimal supervision
- Effectively utilizes all mechanical and basic electrical tools and equipment as needed
- Capable of learning how to operate shop equipment such as mill, lathes, presses, saws, and cutting torches
- Become aware of manufacturers maintenance requirements for assigned lifts
- Maintains accurate records of all work completed or in progress
- Keeps current on all ropeway safety requirements as outlined in the latest edition of the ANSI B77 manual
- Responds quickly and appropriately to lift failures
- Maintains tools, vehicles and equipment in a clean and good working condition
- Assists the Lift Operations supervisor in assessing maintenance systems, schedules, inventory and equipment needs.
- Contributes positively to guest service opportunities
- Follows company and department safety policies

Required Knowledge and Essential Skills


- 5 years' experience in Mechanical and / or electrical experience
- Prior Lift experience preferred
- Ability to multi-task in faced paced work environment
- Radio protocol

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- HS Diploma or equivalent
- A valid Driver's License with good driving record
- Flexible work schedule – must be available to workdays, evenings, weekends and holidays
- Ability to lift/carry 75 pounds
- Must be able to work at height of 75 feet
- Must be able to stand on feet for extended time
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus
- Hearing – to converse with others in a normal conversation
- Balancing, bending, climbing, kneeling, walking, pushing, reaching above shoulders, and sitting
