Track

The track is an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface measuring 30 meters x 60 meters. Rink board padding is in accordance with all applicable guidelines of ISU Communication No. 1512. **For this**

competition a self-standing protective padding system will be utilized. A standard track of 111.12 meters to the lap will be used in accordance with rule 280.

For Division F skaters: The 85m track will be used for this Division group; the ADM guidelines as outlined by US Speed skating will be followed.

Practice fee is \$10 USD per person per session. FAST team drop in fee is \$20 USD (must get approval from FAST team coach before joining session). Fee must be paid at Guest Services **before** practice session.

Late entries will only be accepted until August 8 at 5pm. Online registration will be available and the late fee of \$100 will be added upon completion.

Eligibility

All US participants must be current members of US Speedskating and have a valid USS#. If you are a member of another federation please provide your membership number on the entry form.

Citizenship/ residence requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and the ISU Communication No. 1420, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce and ISU Clearance Certificate.

Safety Requirements

All Participants must wear a helmet, protective gloves, knee pads, neck protection and shin guards and cut resistance protection (either integrated into the suit or as separate underwear). Rule 291 of the ISU Regulations and Communications No. 1265 will be enforced.

Face masks/ coverings

The Utah Olympic Oval does not require face masks/ coverings at this time, to those who are fully vaccinated. We ask that every patron continues to practice healthy habits, to please be respectful of others and social distance. We ask that you are also respectful to those who choose to continue to wear masks.

Seeding Procedure

All division groupings will be based on submitted times. Times must be achieved between July 1, 2021 and March 1, 2022 and be published or recorded in an official event protocol.

In accordance with Rule 119, the ISU, U.S. Speedskating, the Utah Olympic Oval, and the Utah Athletic Foundation assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with this Desert Classic Short Track event.
